

ALABAMA MANDATORY LIABILITY INSURANCE LAW

Beginning January 1, 2013, Shelby County licensing officials must verify **current** liability insurance utilizing the State of Alabama Online Insurance Verification System (OIVS), which allows officials to immediately verify the insurance status of vehicles registered in the State of Alabama.

If for some reason insurance cannot be verified through OIVS, vehicle owners must provide evidence of insurance to the license plate official. The insurance card is the most common evidence of insurance. To be acceptable, the proof of insurance must display the **current** effective date, insurer's NAIC number, vehicle identification number (VIN) and policy number.

In addition to providing evidence of insurance, a **valid** Alabama driver's license, non-driver identification card, or **valid** national driver's license must be provided for an owner reflected on the vehicle title. If the vehicle is company owned then the federal employer identification number (FEIN) is required.

These requirements must be met before registration or renewal can be processed.

Please note: For a new registration a valid Alabama driver's license, non-driver ID or valid national driver's license must be provided for **each** owner reflected on the vehicle title.
